- 3. Submit Essay of no more than 500 words (typed, double spaced) using one of the following prompts:

In June 2017, the LA Community College District released a report revealing that more than 60% of our students experienced food insecurity. 18% were either homeless or in a temporary living situation such as staying with relatives or friends, in a shelter, or couch-surfing, making them at risk for academic failure. Your college campus may already be addressing these problems. In your essay, discuss what, if anything, your college does to deal with these issues for students and what it additionally could do to alleviate these conditions. You might want to interview other students, faculty, and administrators for ideas and information.

Restrictive voting laws have a disproportionate impact on the political power of communities of color, women and the poor, denying them the power to elect candidates with shared values.

Explain some strategies that a labor union has used in the past to effectively improve access to the vote, and what efforts should labor organizations implement in future to increase access to the vote, especially for disenfranchised (defined as "denied the right to vote") communities.

Recent actions initiated by various unions in 2023 has been called the Summer of Strikes. How is a labor union effective in creating better benefits and greater recognition for their members? How could a labor union also be effective in bringing policy change on a larger scale? Choose one labor union as an example and interview one or more people who are members of that labor union about their views on how their union has helped them.
